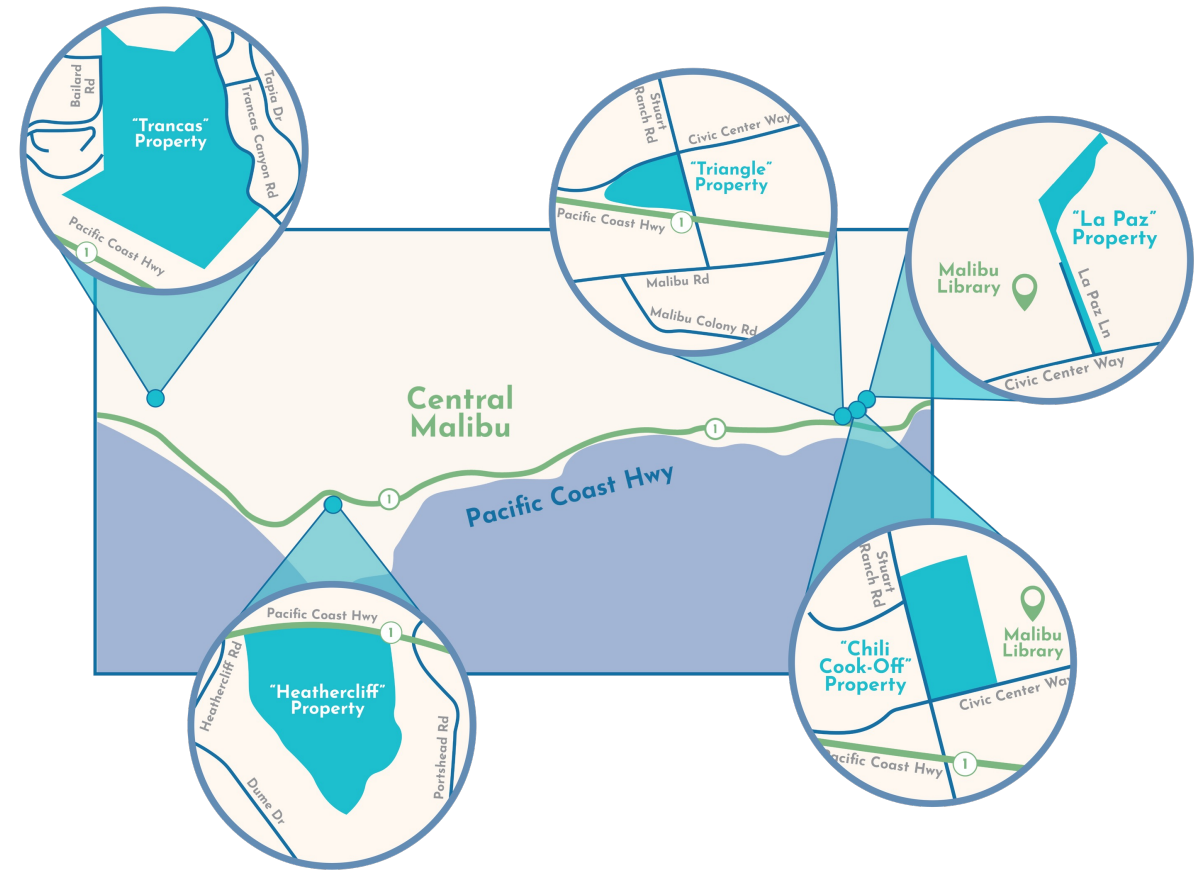

- In 2012, the Parks and Recreation Commission gathered information from Malibu residents and stakeholders in the community on opinions on parks, facilities and program needs.
- As a lot of things may have changed since the last survey that was done over a decade ago, the City has developed an innovative outreach program designed to engage a diverse cross-section of the community.

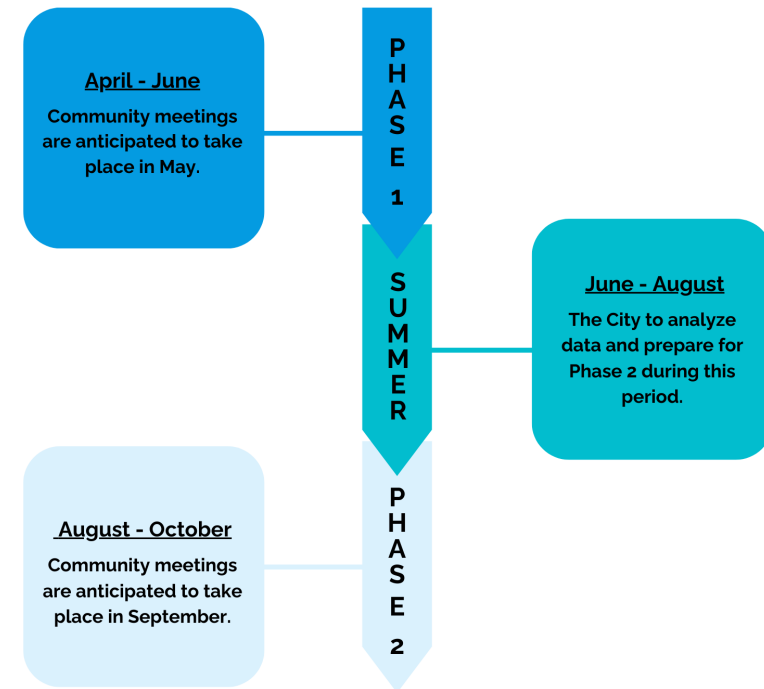
Outreach Program Goals

- In Phase 2, we will be looking for more narrow feedback and specifics for each community land

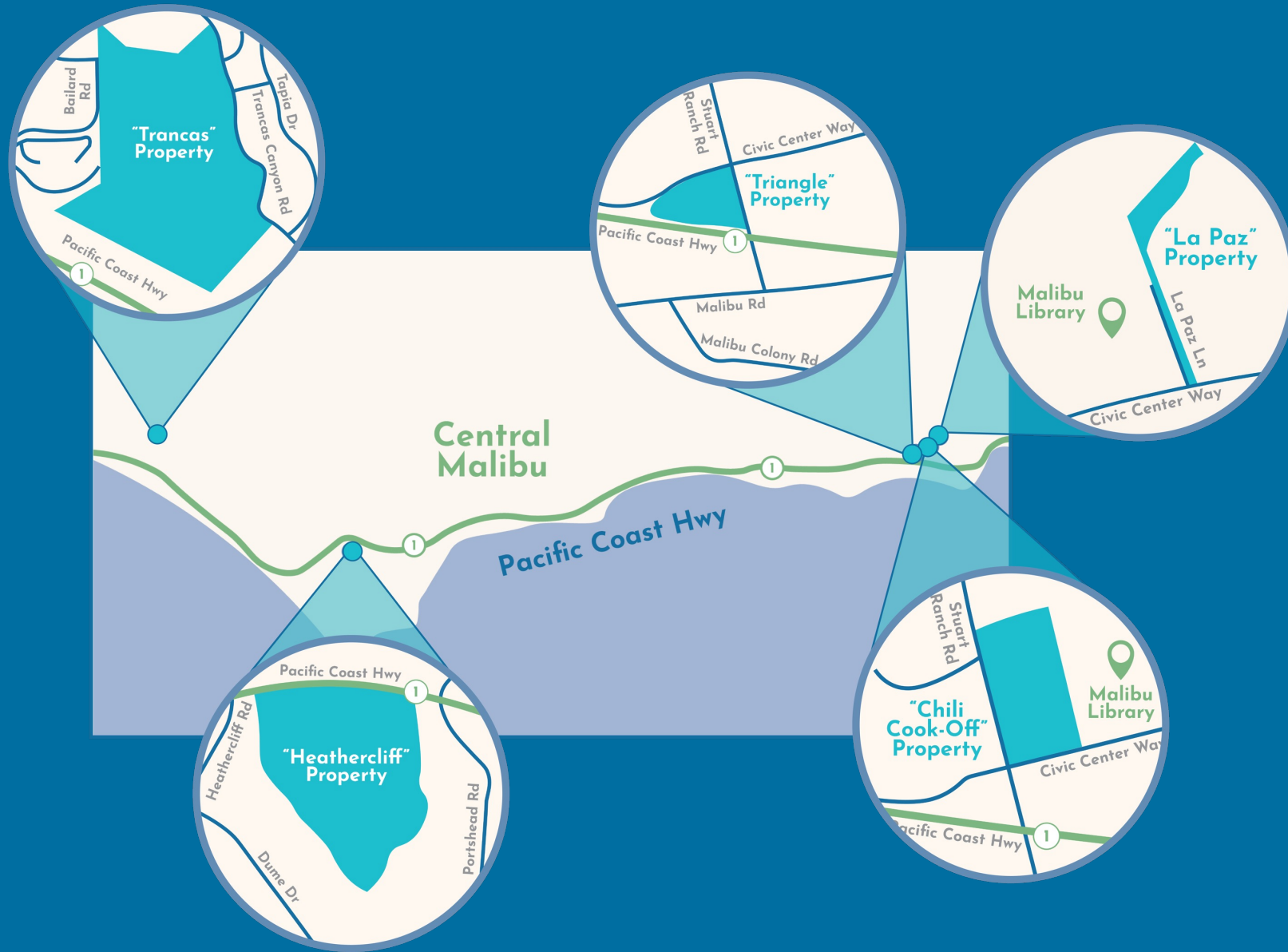

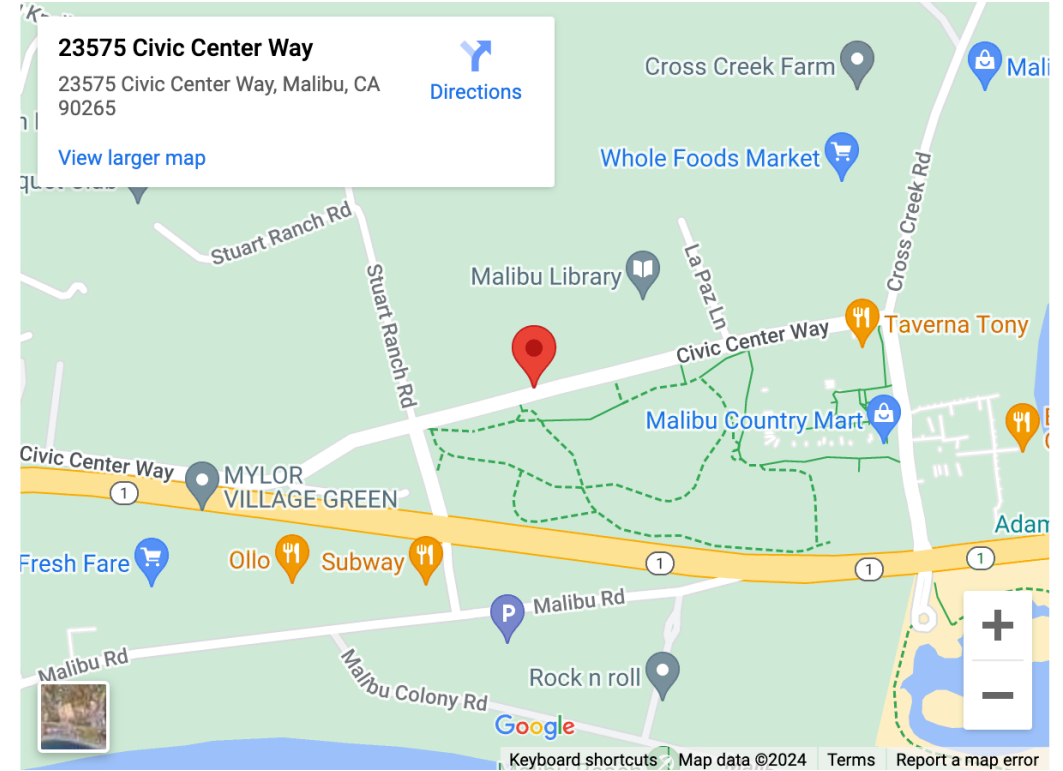
- Collect your feedback on the types of uses you would like to see for these community lands

Where are the community lands located?



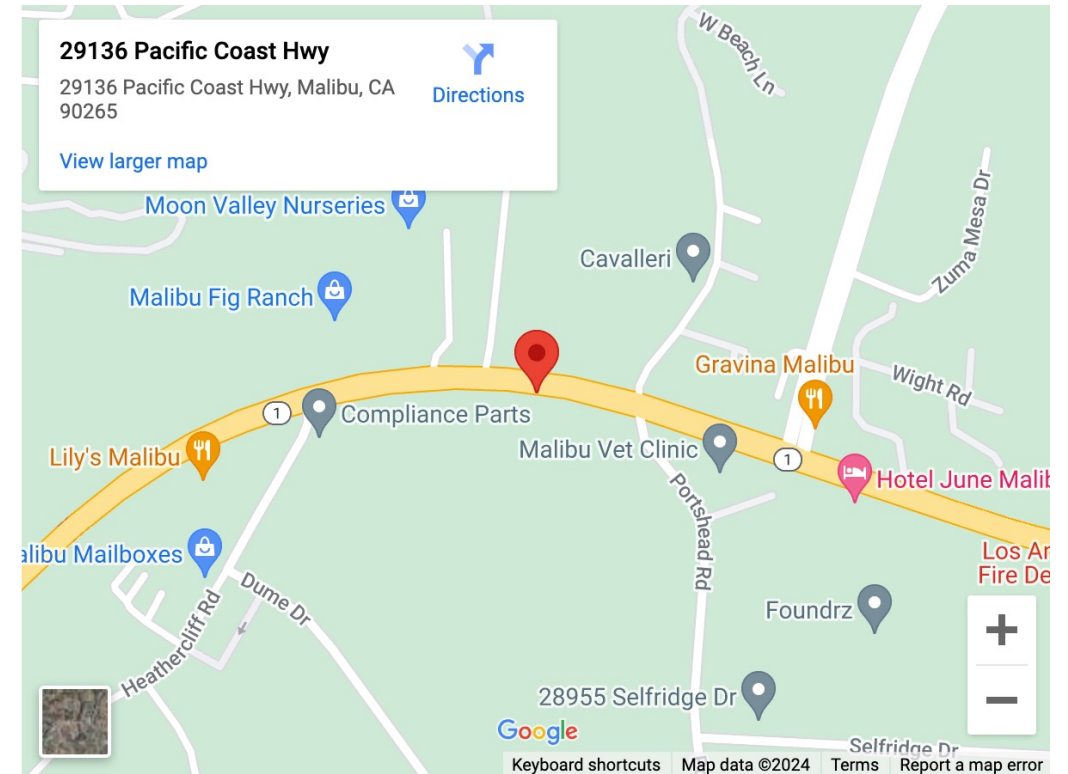

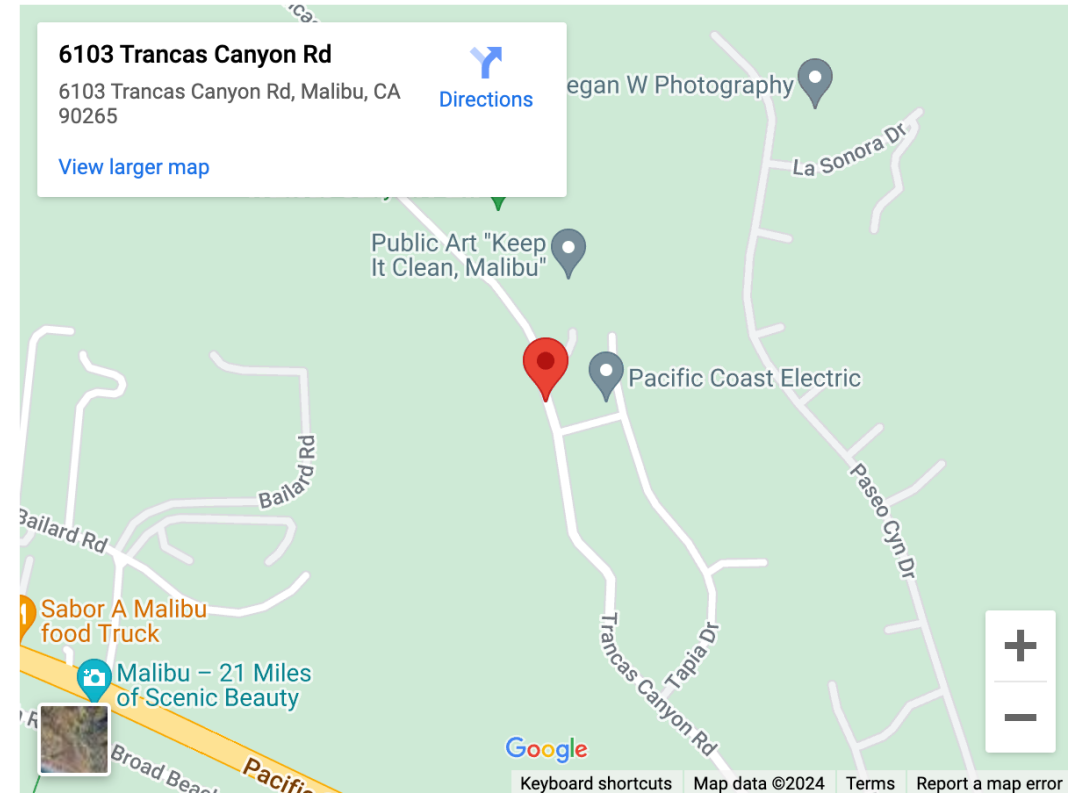
“Triangle”

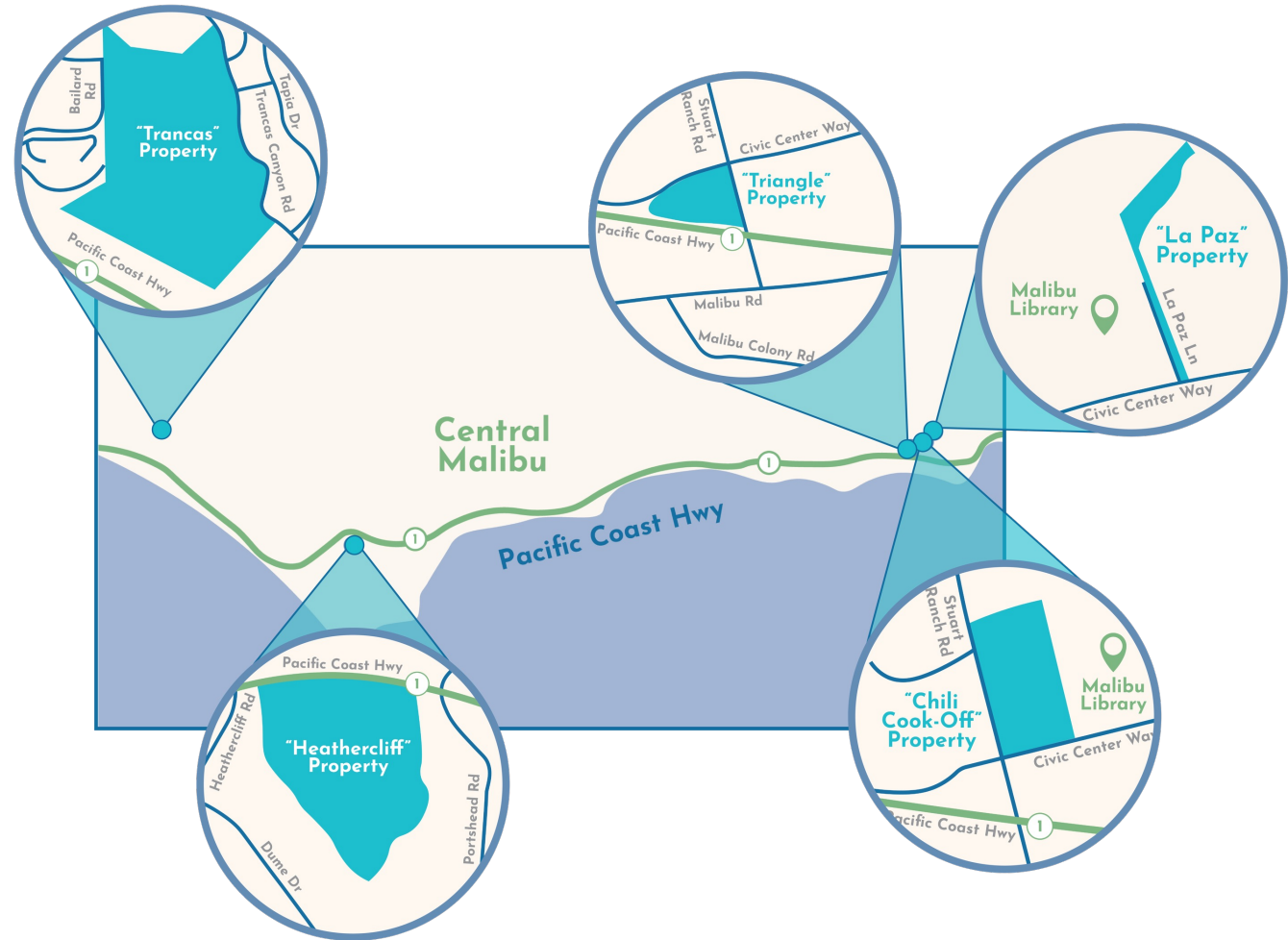

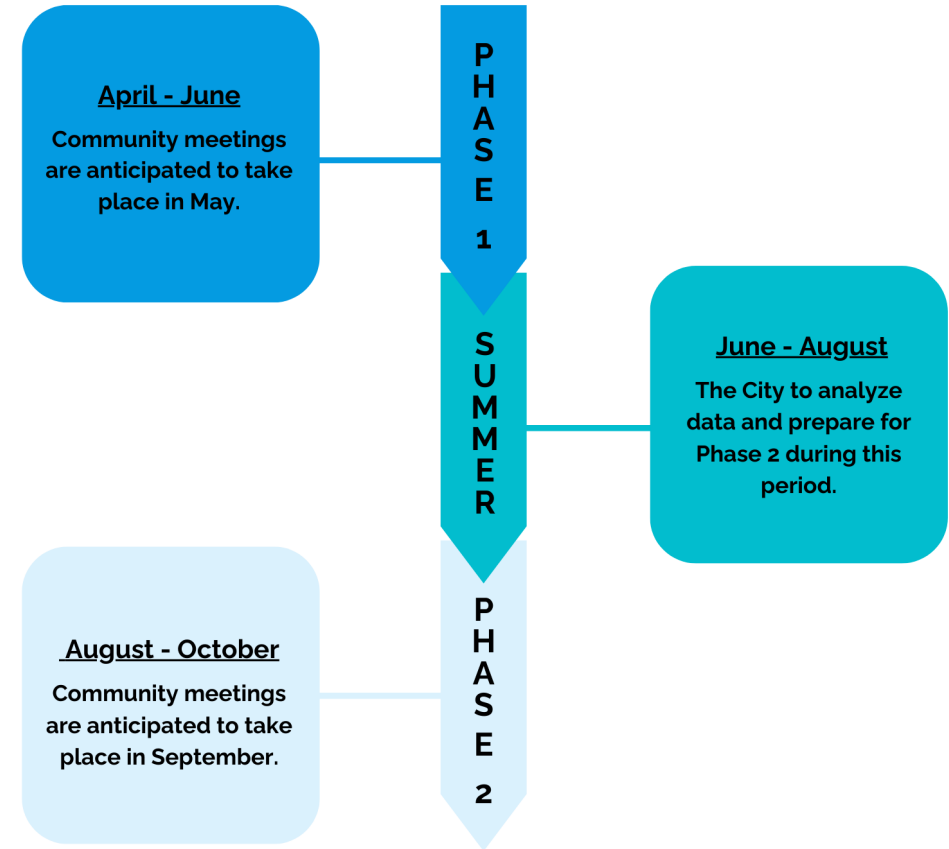

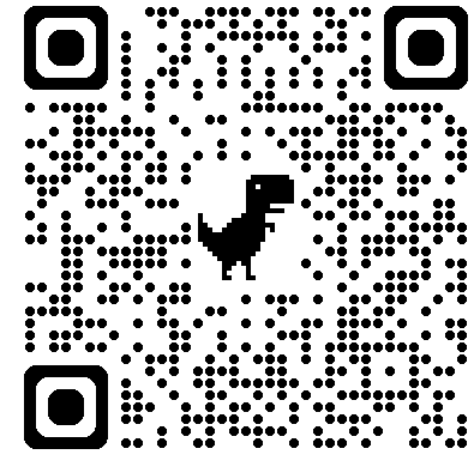
Stay Involved



Background

The City of Malibu currently owns five parcels of vacant land spanning just over 61 acres. To ensure the future of these community lands aligns with the community's priorities, the City of Malibu is launching a robust outreach and engagement program to collect your feedback.
